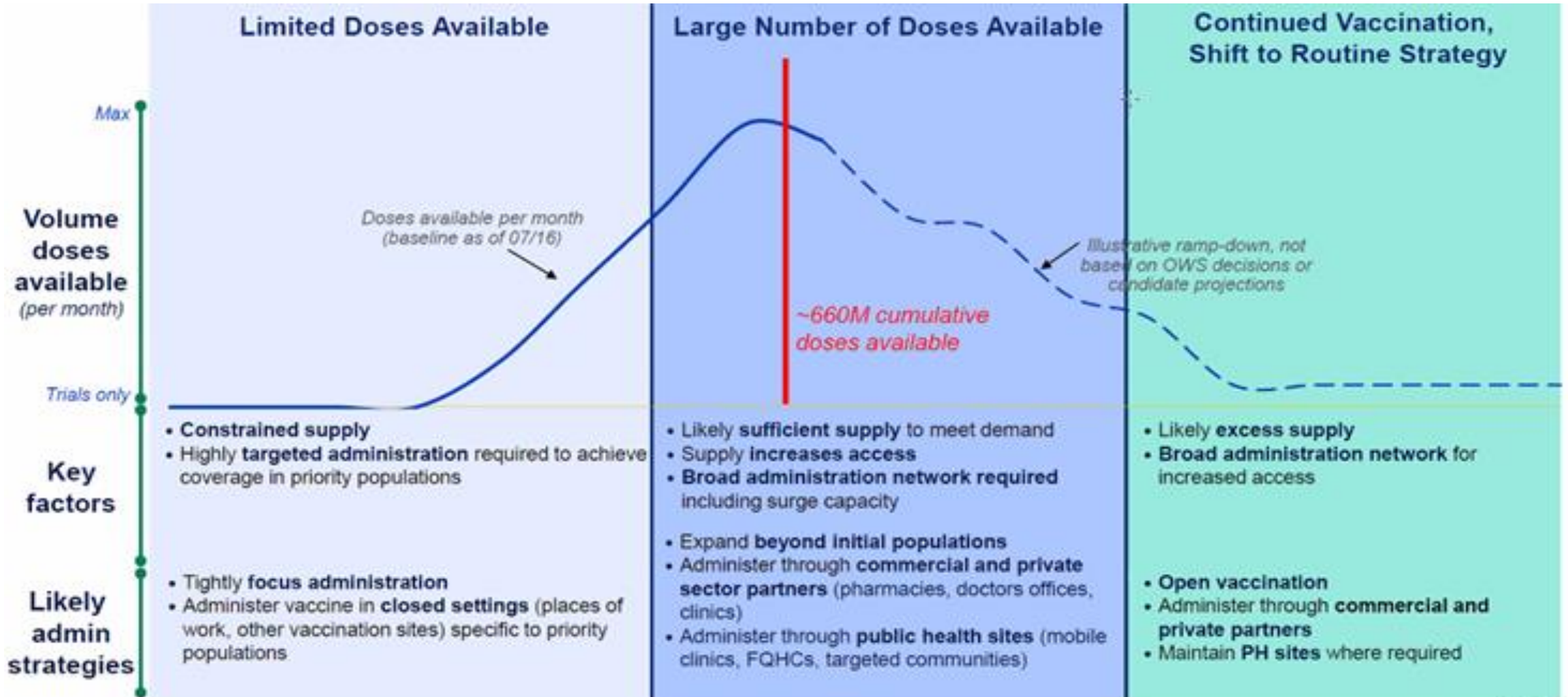

Phased approach to administering COVID-19 vaccine



State Directs Vaccine Operations

1 Phases and Priority Groups

Uses **latest CDC guidance** and knowledge of state-wide conditions to **establish priority groups** for vaccine providers

3 CVMS – COVID Vaccine Management System

State-wide electronic registration system to be in place, but **not yet live**

Vaccine Distribution

Licenses vaccine providers

Currently 4 in Wake County with broad distribution – **WCPH, UNC Rex, Duke Raleigh, WakeMed**

Determines **distribution quantities**

Public Information

Establishes avenues for access – **location**

Education – availability, safety and effectiveness of vaccine

Previous Phases and Subgroups are now Groups

In Wake, 180,000 people are in Groups 1 and 2

Why these Priority Groups?

Group 1: Protect **health care workers** who are a critical workforce during the COVID-19 pandemic and at risk for exposure to COVID-19 and **long-term care residents** and workers who are at the highest risk of being hospitalized or dying

Group 2: Save lives by protecting those at high risk of being hospitalized or dying from COVID-19.

Why start with People ≥ 65 years?

Core principle: Protect people who are at the highest risk of being hospitalized or dying.

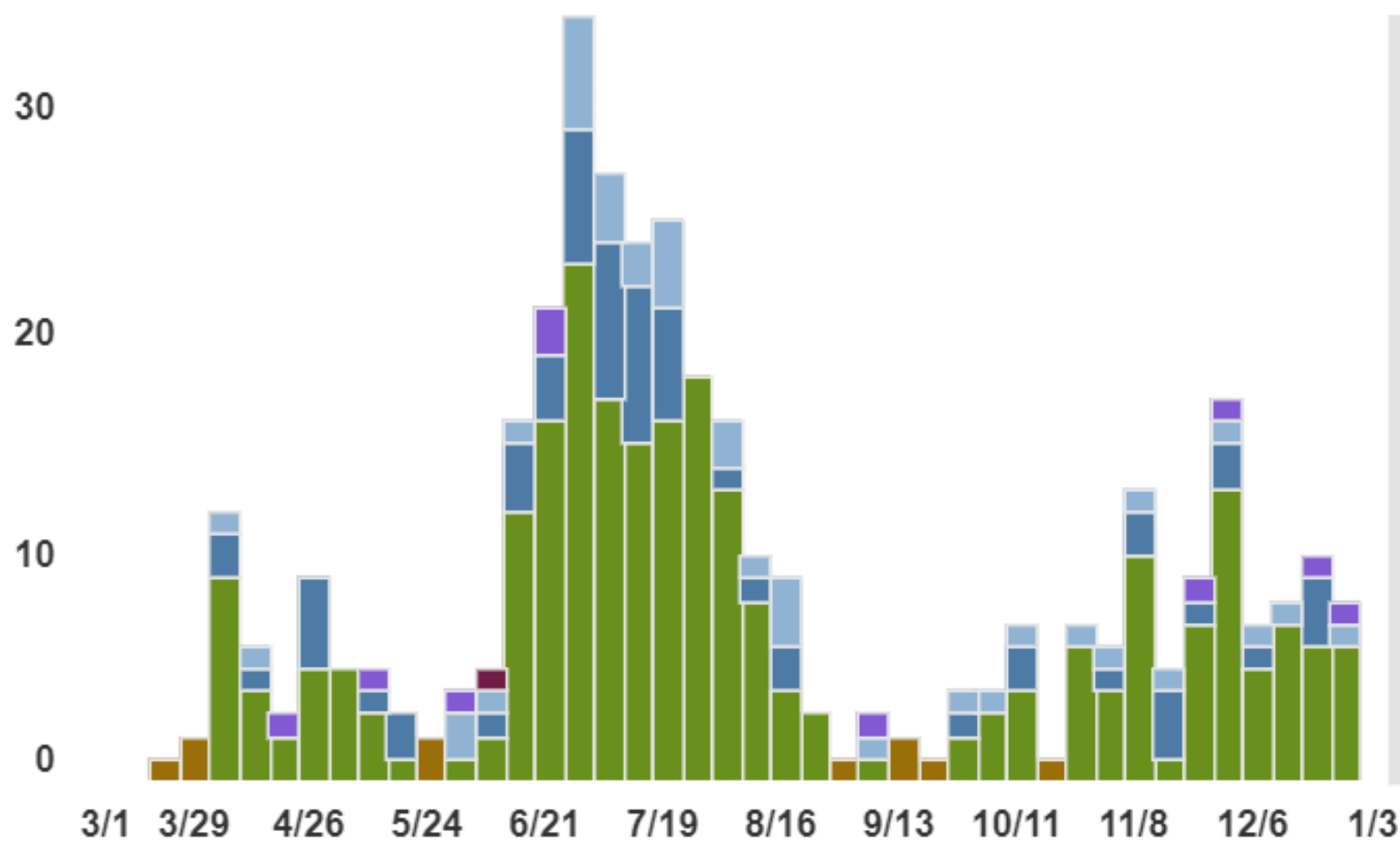
	% of Cases	% of Deaths
NC ≥ 75	7%	60%
NC ≥ 65	15%	83%
US ≥ 65	14.4%	80.7%

As of December 20, 2020, the cumulative COVID-19-associated hospitalization rate was **1,211 per 100,000 for persons aged ≥ 75 years** and **642 per 100,000 for persons aged 65-74 years**.

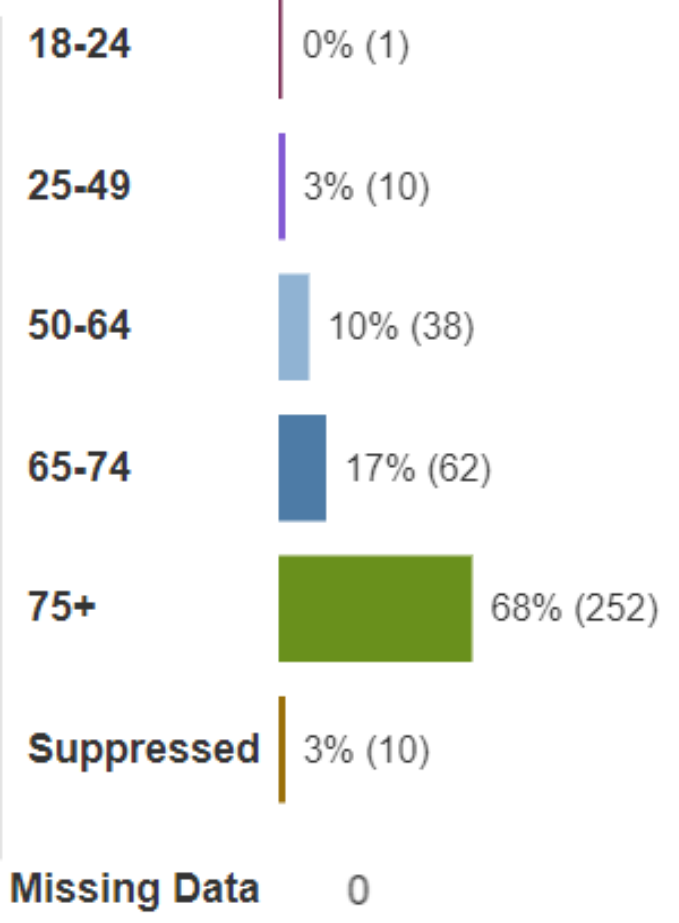
Deaths by Age for Wake County



Weekly Deaths Trend



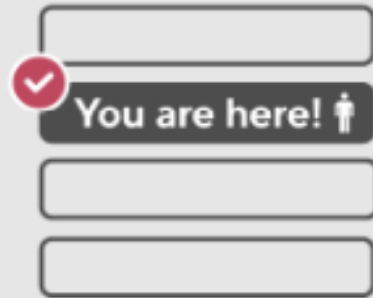

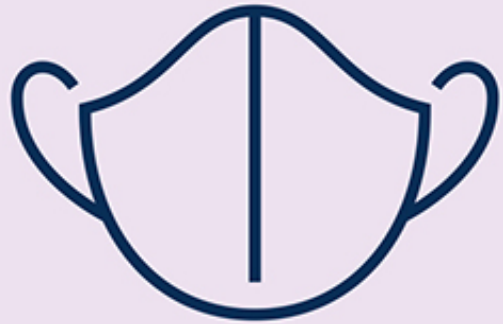
Demand far exceeds supply

As of 11:30 this morning, had received request for over 8,000 people to be on the waiting list for vaccine
