

The superintendent shall establish child nutrition services consistent with Wake County Board of Education goals as provided in policy 6200, Goals of Child Nutrition Services, state and federal laws and regulations, and the recommendations of the Department of Public Instruction. The superintendent may direct the development of regulations and procedures that will include a delineation of the responsibilities of the school principals and of the child nutrition services administrative staff.

The child nutrition services senior director shall be appointed by the Board upon the recommendation of the superintendent and shall be responsible for the conduct of those duties and responsibilities as set forth in the job description. Duties related to the other child nutrition services staff should be included in appropriate job descriptions. Principals and cafeteria managers are responsible for the child nutrition services programs in their schools, under the supervision of the senior director.

The superintendent shall verify that all child nutrition services personnel are certified and trained in accordance with the law.
