Key Points

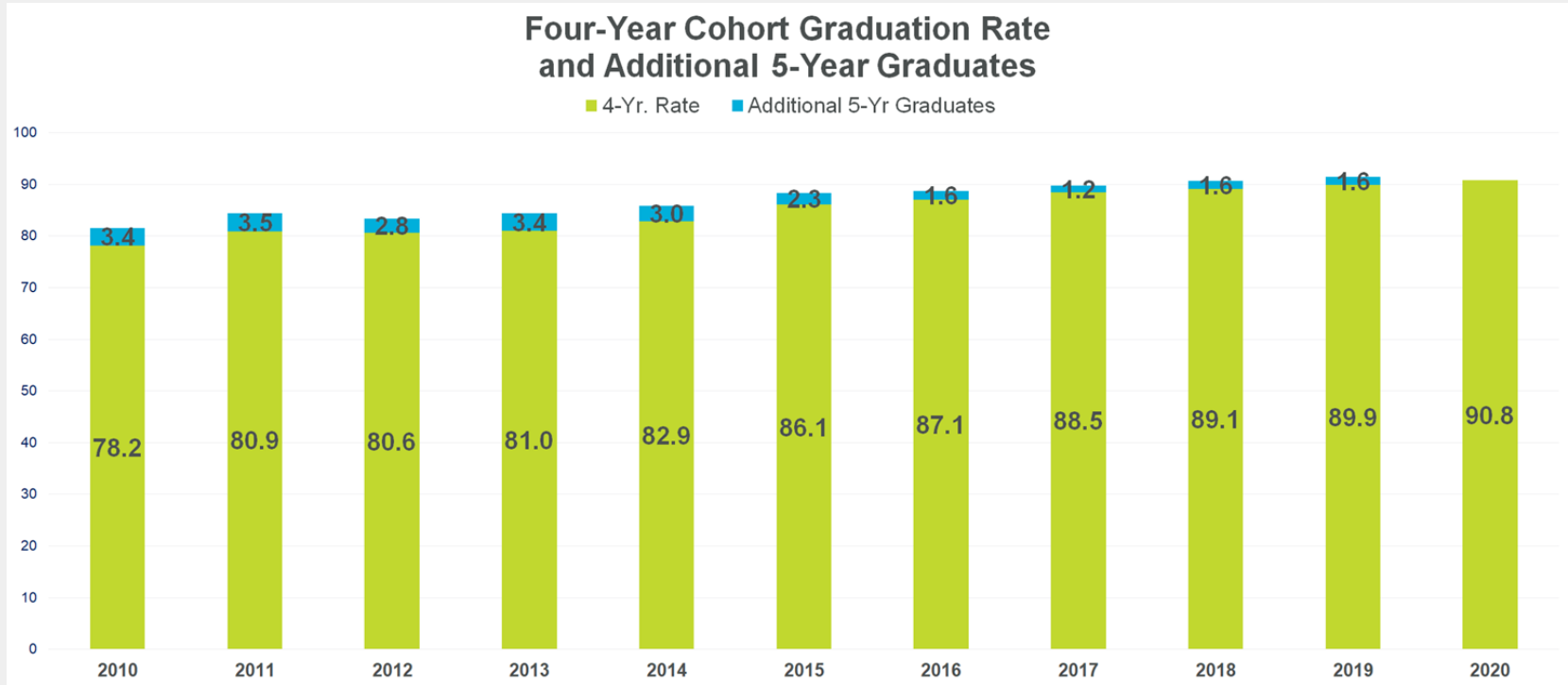
- Significant progress has been made on the graduation rate
 - Consistent year-over-year increases; Highest rate ever in 2020
 - Gaps are closing
- Work remains to be done (Nov 2019 SAC Presentation)
 - Non-graduates show struggles during the elementary and middle grades
 - Students moving into WCPSS in the later grades more likely to be non-graduates
- Supporting metrics on college, career, and citizenship readiness are mixed.
Examples:
 - Metrics that are Up: Industry credentials, voter registration, GPA, college-going, tech skills
 - Metrics that are Down: Interest in current events, community involvement, *some* EOGs, CWRA+ scores

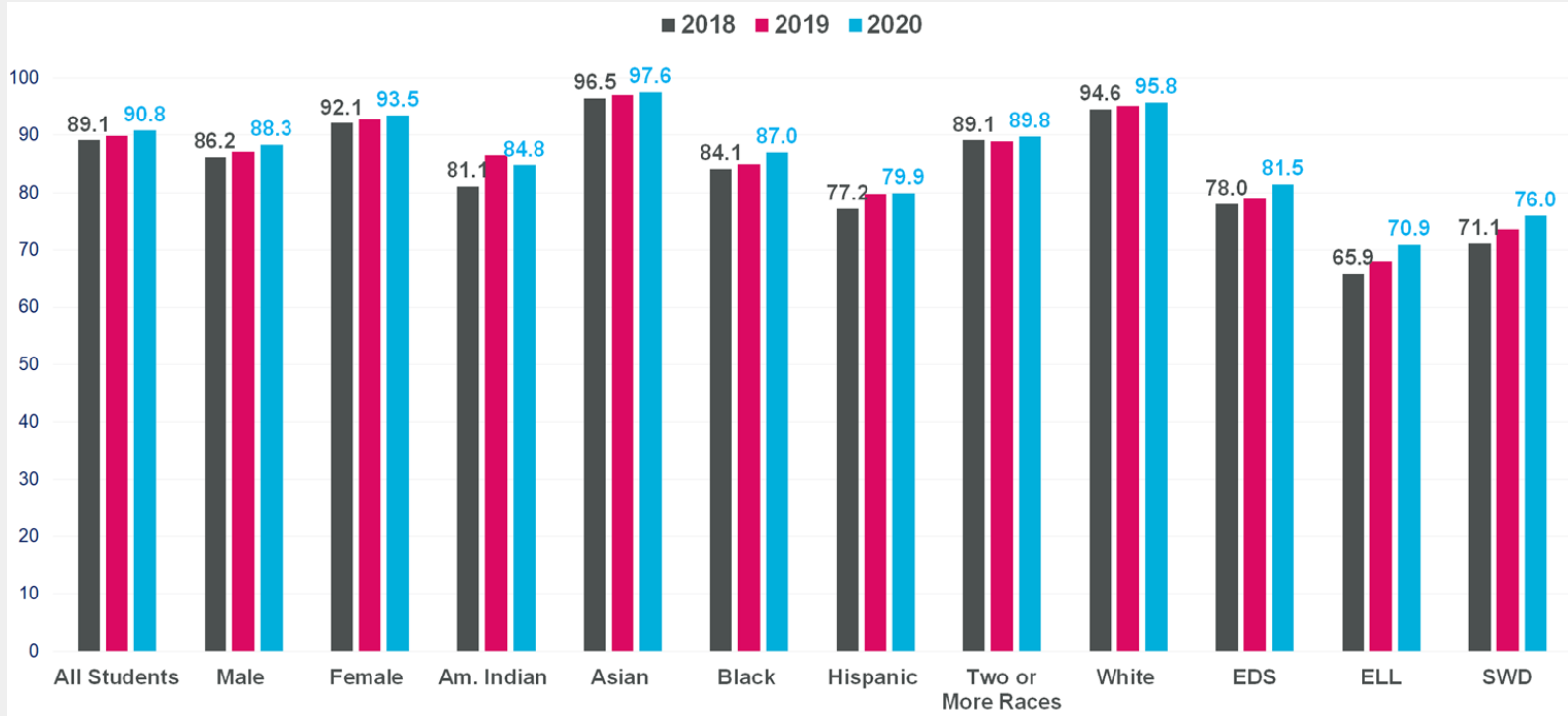


By 2020, WCPSS will annually graduate at least 95% of its students ready for productive citizenship as well as higher education or a career.

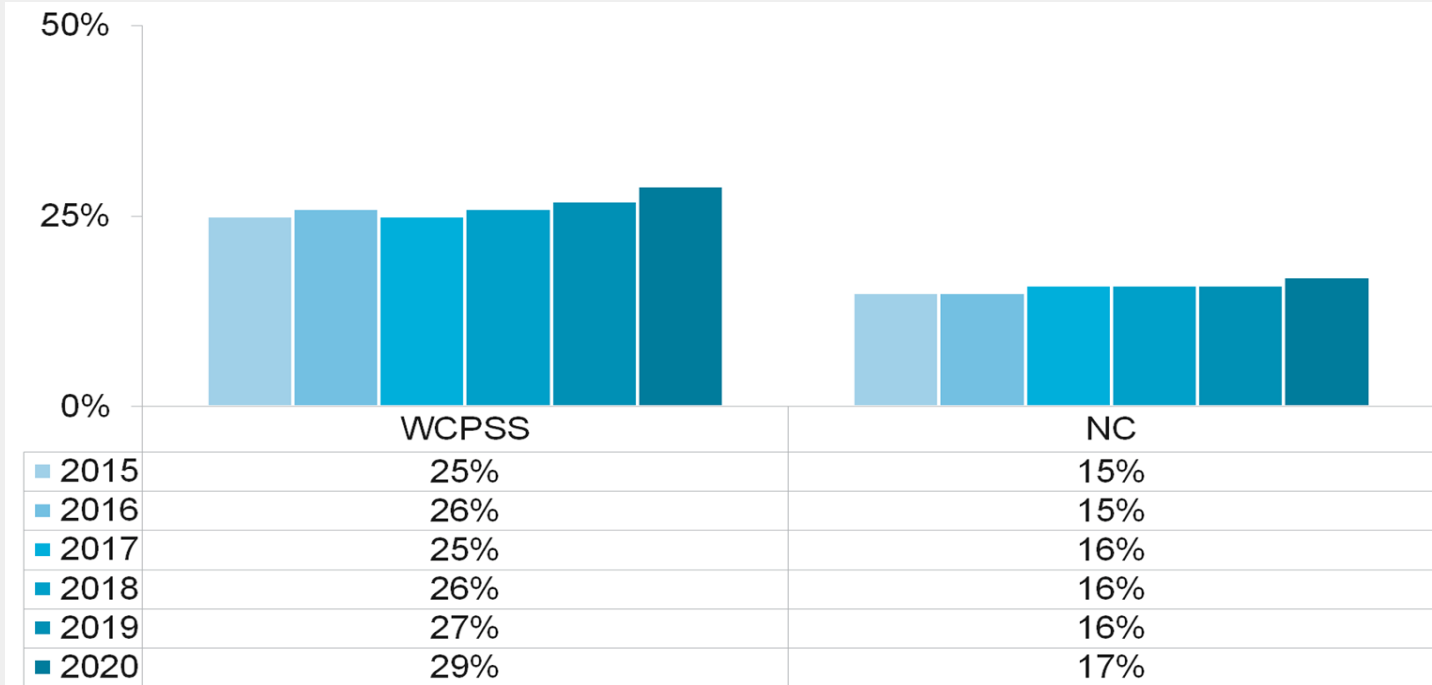

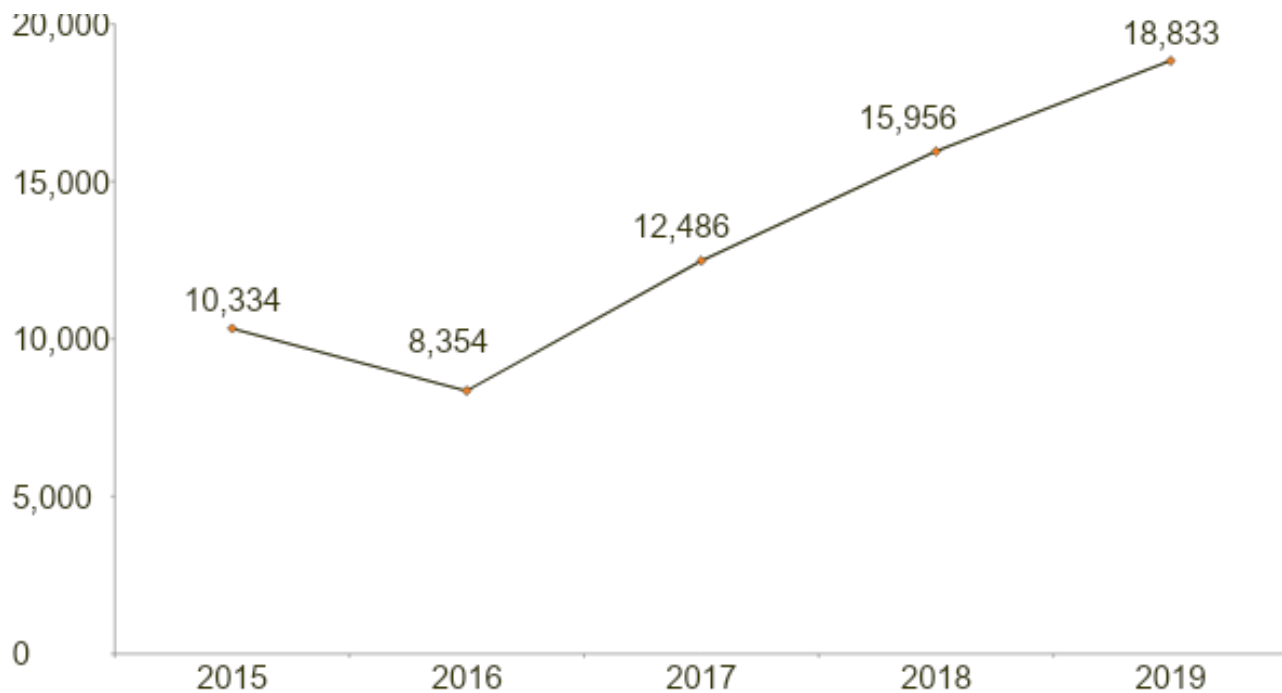
Percent Meeting ACT College-Ready Benchmarks All 4 Subjects (Juniors)



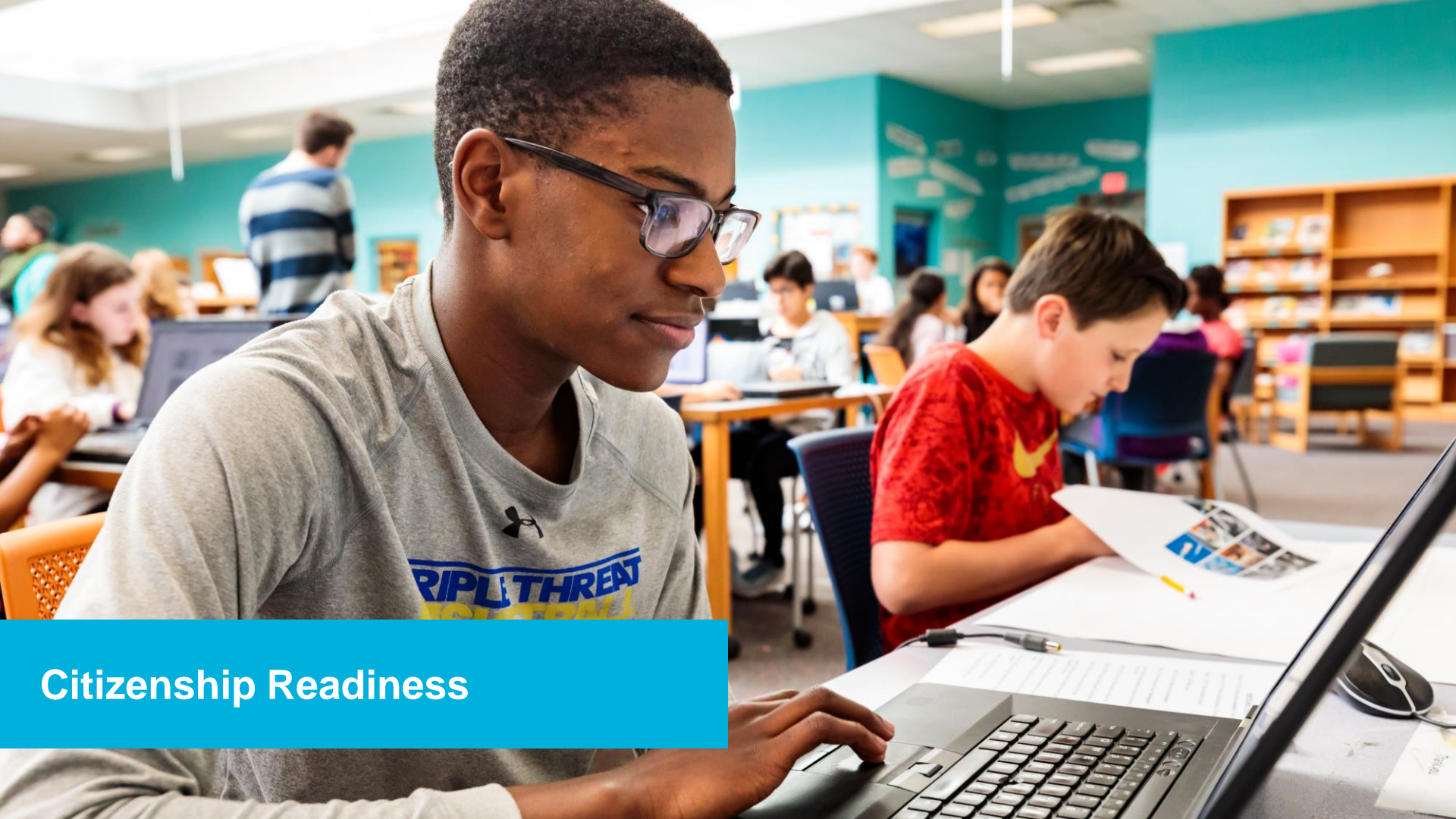

Industry Credentials/Certifications Earned by WCPSS HS Students

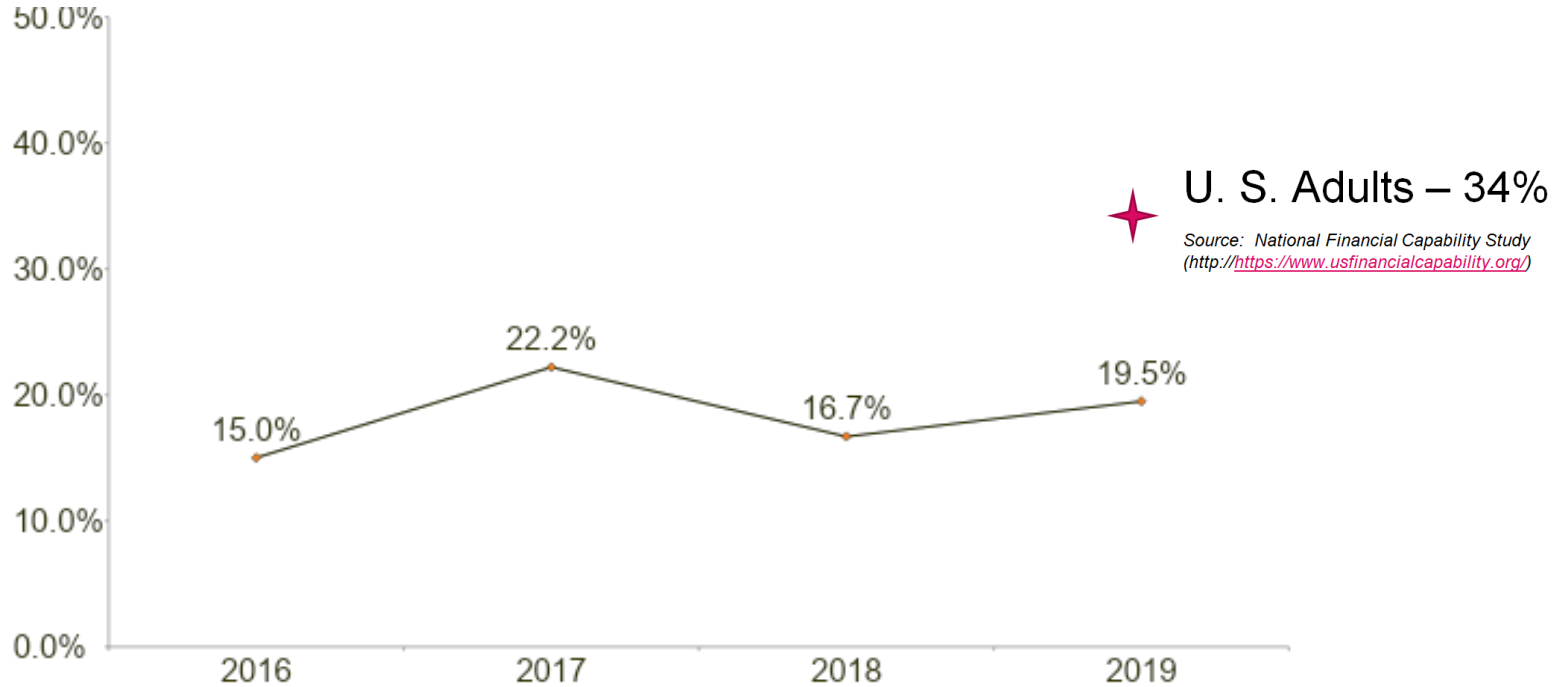
