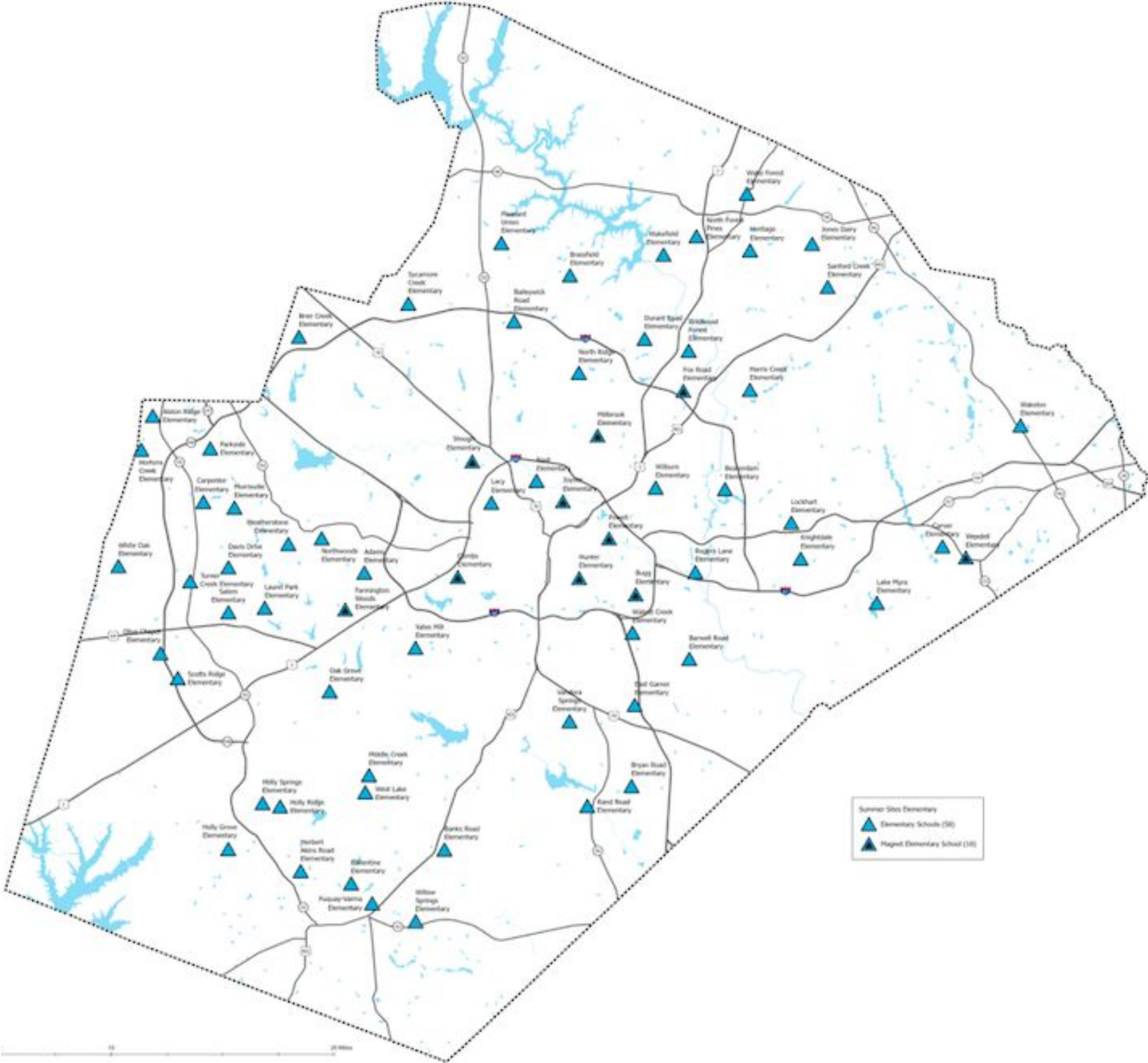

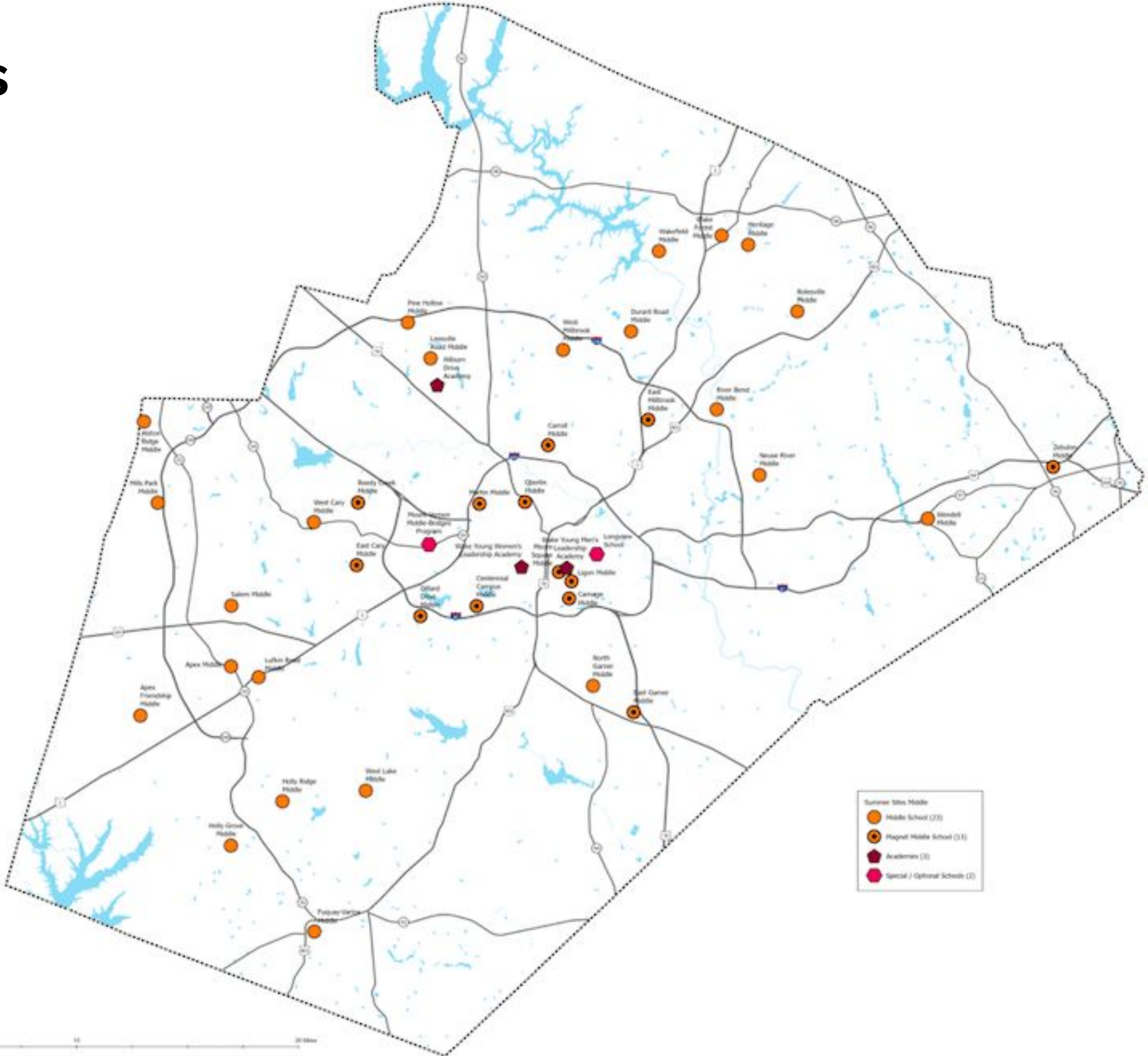

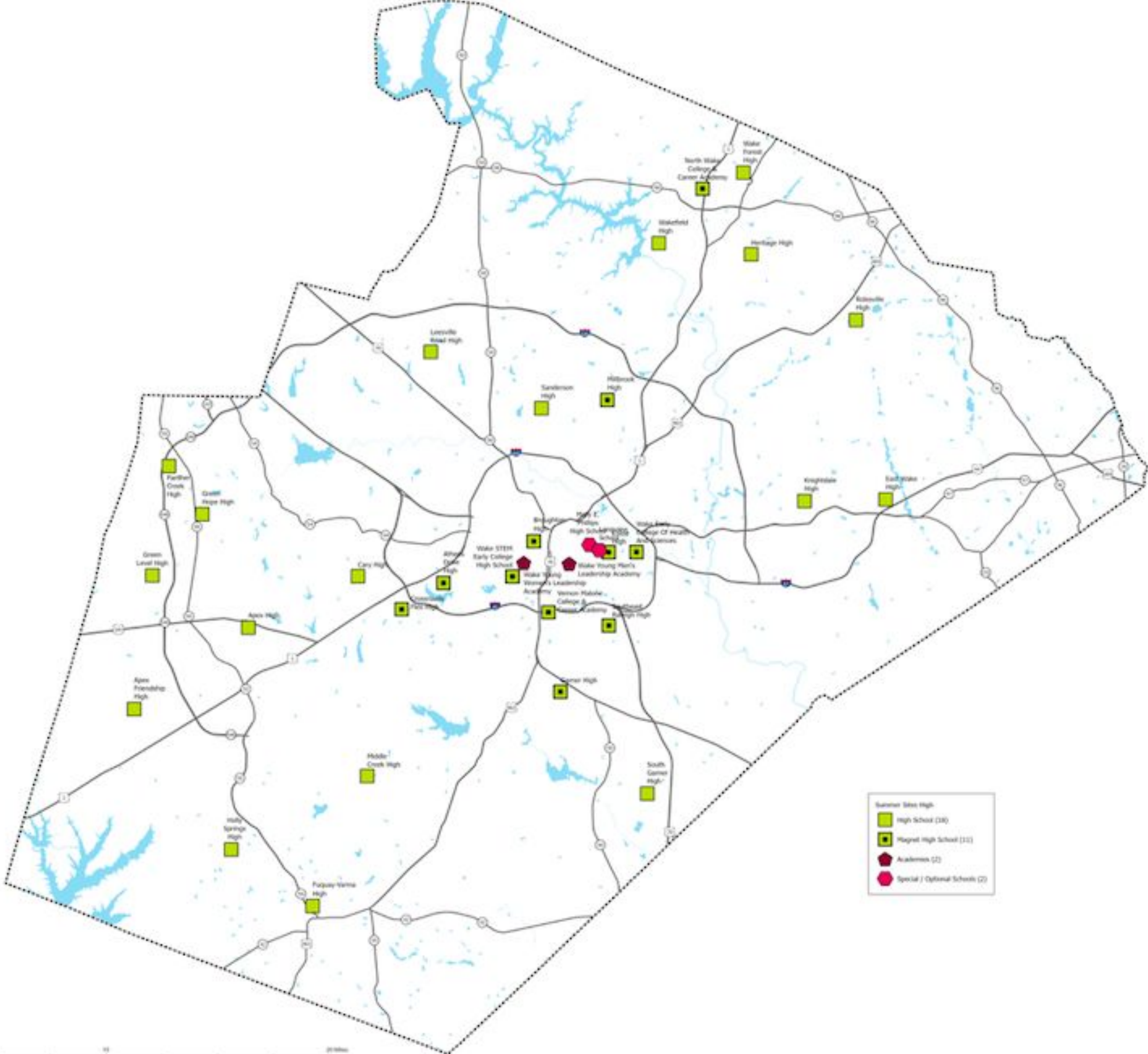

# Update on Student Registration for Camp WCPSS

## Family Notification

- 23,000+ Students Invited
- 19,086 Accepted (Reflects an increase of 2,374 students from the last update)
  - 12,132 Elementary
  - 3,269 Middle
  - 3,685 High
- 83% Acceptance Rate



# Update on Student Registration for Camp WCPSS

## Enrolled Students

- Elementary:
  - 87% of students attending meet the district definition of at risk
  - 10% of students (1198) attending were identified as at risk by the school beyond the district definition
  - 3% of students (342) are attending by choice and are not at risk
  - About 240 students are on a wait list
- Secondary:
  - ~ 85% of students attending meet the district definition of at risk
  - ~ 13-14% of students (1,127) attending were identified as at risk by the school beyond the district definition
  - ~ 1-2% of students (162) are attending by choice and are not at risk
  - About 540 students are on a wait list



# Recruiting Highly Effective Teachers & Staff

## **School-Based Positions Include Approximately:**

- 2,300 Teacher Positions
- 950 Instructional Assistant Positions
- 138 Counselors
- 135 Clerical Assistant Positions

## **Largest Remaining Needs:**

- Special Education Classrooms: ECS Classrooms & General Curriculum
- ESL Teachers
- Year-Round Teachers



# Recruiting Highly Effective Teachers & Staff

## Strategies to Continuously Recruit

- Incentive Pay & Bonus Structure
- Assessing the current status of internal & external applicants and working to match interest with needs within the region.
- Working individually with schools to match teachers in the region with open positions.



## Monitoring Student Learning & Progress

**Short Term:** Formative assessments are built into the curriculum to gauge and assess student understanding throughout the experience. K-8 students will receive a pre/post assessment in reading and math per DPI guidelines.

**Long Term:** The goal of the experience is to establish a foundation for students to ensure readiness and success during the 2021-22 school year.

- Comparison of ELA and Math first semester grades from 2021 to first semester 2022.
- Comparison of Number Knowledge Test (NKT) End of Year score 2020-21 to NKT Beginning of the Year score 2021-22 (grades K-2).
- Comparison of credit attainment gaps comparing Fall 2019 vs. Fall 2021.
- Continued support through the use of the additional Intervention months of employment.



# Timeline for Next Steps

## Next Steps

- Continued recruitment of staff for open positions.
- School and district efforts to support family engagement for students who are attending Camp WCPSS as well as students who were identified but could not attend.
- Professional learning and supports for schools to build structures around progress monitoring and responding to learning data.
