- I have served as the executive director of the Alice Aycock Poe Center for Health Education for 12 years where I manage an operating budget over \$3 million. I provide our Board of Directors recommendations for our annual operating budget, capital budgets, auditors, financial services, and compliance. I am retired after 40 years as a Microbiologist in the Pathology Department at WakeMed. I worked with the Wake County Public School System where I was the administrator of the Partnership for Educational Success and Parent Liaison Programs. In this role I identified, coordinated, budgeted, and implemented programs and strategies that linked families and the community with the schools to strengthen student success in partnership with the Wake County Human Services staff. I began working with Wake County Public School System as the MentorWake Administrator. In this position, I oversaw all aspects of program operations including the selecting of students, recruitment, screening, training, budgets, and support of volunteer mentors, and the matching of volunteer mentors to referred students.
