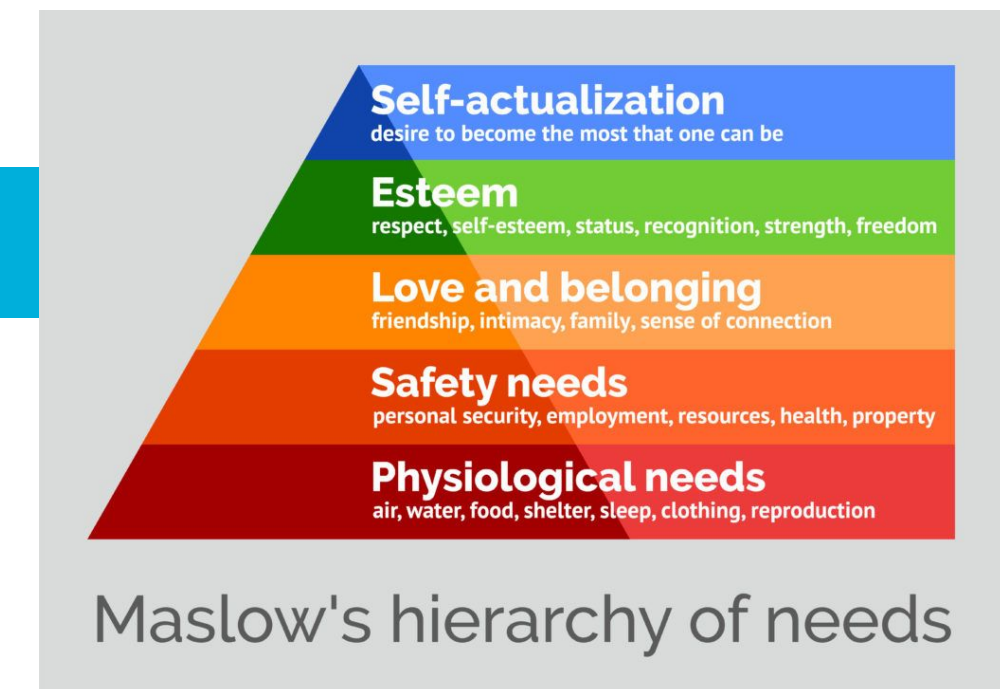

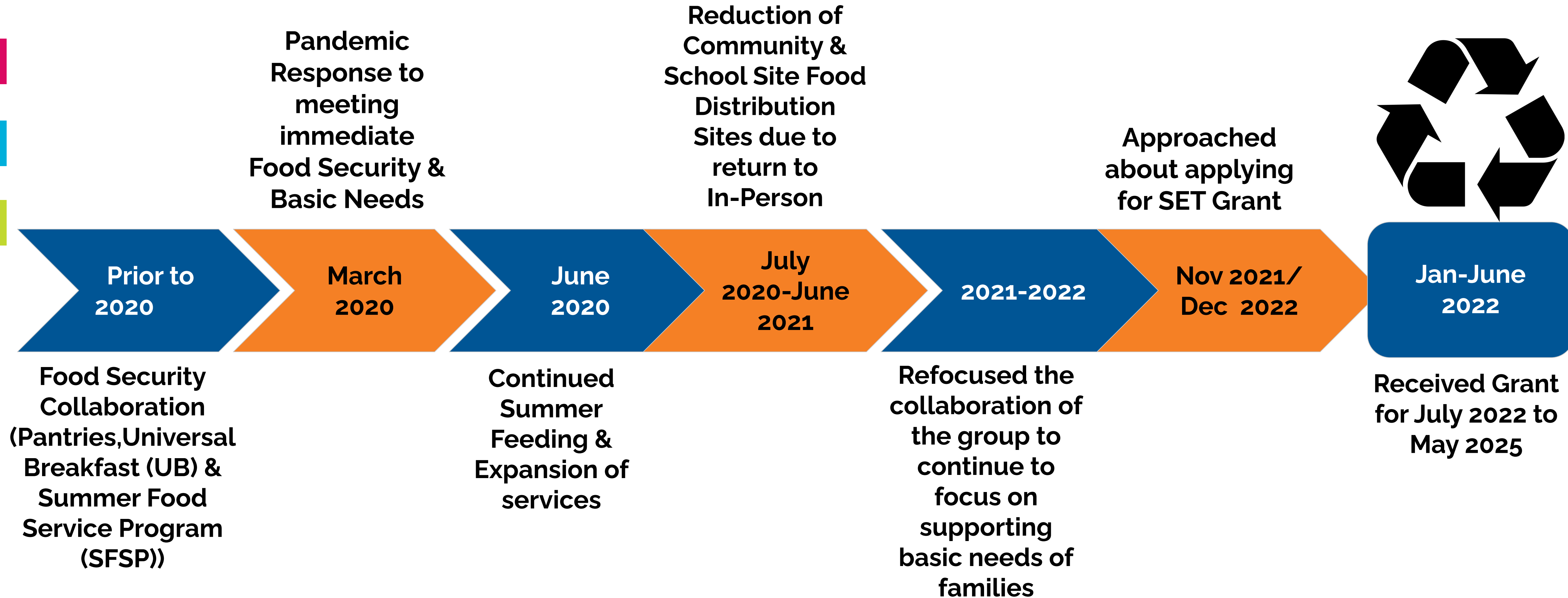

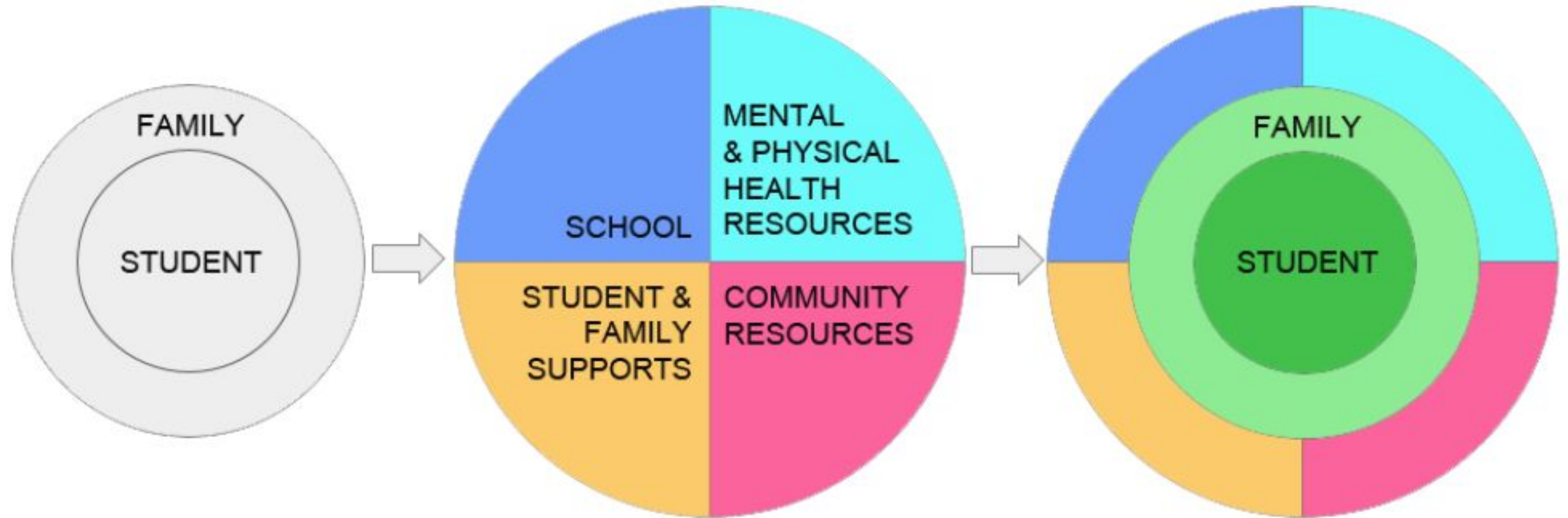

Wake County Cooperative Extension

Services to Families

- Family Life Coaches focus initially on family engagement followed by assessment, interventions, life planning & resources.
- Integrate age appropriate coaching for youth and link to positive youth development in the community.

Work with Schools

- Partner with schools to address the needs of the 25 families identified at each school (100 students total)

4-H Family Coaches (4 positions, 1 at each school)

Services to Families

- Serve as an additional support to families with school and community needs

Work with Schools

Program Manager

- Supports school principals and student services staff
- Ensures families are receiving services
- Collaborate with Family Engagement (OEA)

Data Analyst

- Analyzes data and prepares reports
