The superintendent shall establish school child nutrition services consistent with Wake County Board of Education goals as provided in policy 6200, Goals of School Child Nutrition Services, and state and federal laws and regulations, and the recommendations of the Department of Public Instruction. The superintendent shall may direct the development of regulations and procedures that will include a delineation of the responsibilities of the school principals and of the school child nutrition services administrative staff.

The school child nutrition services senior director shall be appointed by the Board upon the recommendation of the superintendent and shall be responsible for the conduct of those duties and responsibilities as set forth in the job description. Duties related to the other child nutrition services staff should be included in appropriate job descriptions. Each principal and cafeteria manager is responsible for the school child nutrition services program in his or her school, under the supervision of the senior director of child nutrition.

The superintendent shall verify that all school child nutrition services personnel are certified and trained in accordance with the law.
